

Agreement for the use of the "Riyadh Elm University website"

Agreement:

1. This agreement governs your use of the Riyadh Elm University website.
2. The site management reserves the right to change or modify part or all of this agreement at any time, so that those changes will take effect upon announcing them directly on the site.
