

# **Commitment to the principles of intellectual property rights and copyright**

## **Riyadh Elm University's commitment to intellectual property rights when publishing:**

The site administration is committed to the principles of intellectual property rights when designing and uploading any content on the university's website, such as texts, images, programs, designs, training content, or others.

The intellectual property of the digital content published on the university's website, including articles, programs, designs, images, and others, belongs to Riyadh Elm University.

## **Lecturers' commitment to intellectual property rights when displaying educational content on the university's website**

Lecturers who wish to upload their educational content are bound by the principles of intellectual property rights and copyright. Where the lecturer signs a pledge form and acknowledges that the educational content presented in the lectures respects all intellectual property laws and copyrights, usage, modification, and mixing. The lecturers also undertake to refer to the scientific references and sources that he benefited from in preparing the educational content, and in the event that the lecturer uses educational content that he does not own his intellectual property or does not mention the references and sources in it, he bears the legal responsibility for that.

## **Lecturer's commitment when uploading educational content to the university's website:**

The lecturers acknowledge that all digital educational content uploaded to the Riyadh Elm University website, including recorded lectures, assignments, or various educational objects, must respect intellectual property rights and copyright principles. The lecturers also acknowledge that all educational content uploaded to the Riyadh Elm University website becomes At the disposal of RIU, which may use it for research or academic purposes.

Among the copyright controls that the site management is committed to and explained to all beneficiaries are the following:

1. It is prohibited to publish any educational content that exposes people or institutions that appear in it in a bad way.
2. Infringement is prohibited by publishing or quoting content with intellectual rights without permission or approval.
3. It is forbidden to publish any content contrary to the prevailing religious or moral teachings in society.
4. It is forbidden to publish any content that affects national unity (racist, sectarian, tribal...).
5. It is prohibited to publish or promote any content or product with commercial objectives.
